The Future City Competition Program is an Engineer’s Week student outreach activity in New Jersey that has brought together the education community, local engineering alumni, engineering firms and various professional societies to design a city of the future that solves the annual challenge. Students start in the fall and present their city at the NJ Regional Competition in January. In recent years our NJ region competition has grown to over 500 participating students, teachers, and mentors. Our mission is to provide a fun and exciting educational engineering program for 6th, 7th & 8th grade students that combine a stimulating engineering challenge with a “hands-on” application to present their vision of a city of the future.
